HICE works together with numerous organizations to promote international exchange and interculturalism at the citizen level in Hamamatsu. Alongside offering Japanese language classes and multilingual consultations, HICE also undertakes international exchange and understanding events, support for citizens' activities and volunteers, information provision, and various other activities.



Social Welfare Council

These are private organizations organized nationally by prefecture or municipality and are defined in Article 109 of the Social Welfare Law as 'organizations whose purpose is to promote community welfare'. They carry out a variety of activities aimed at creating 'welfare community development', where locals can live in comfort and security in their own towns.
